



1. Cut the heads off the flowers, leaving a short amount of stem.
2. Attach a peg to each flower head by the stem to make it easier to pick up.
3. Pour some paint into the trays or containers.
4. Dip the flower heads into the trays.
5. Carefully print with the flower heads onto paper.

Flower Printing

- Various spring flowers
- Trays or containers
- Paint
- Paper
- Pegs

- 2: Guess the initial letter sounds or colours or make a silly story up using the object picked out.






Put a wash on!
