- Cardboard box
- Pencil
- Scraps of fabric

WHAT TO DO:

- Punch some holes in the box with the pencil.
- Use the pencil to push your scraps into the holes.
- Make a picture, a pattern or a **rainbow!**





A really different way to make a picture! Children will love making the holes in the cardboard box.

Cloud Dough... (2 ingredients!)

- Mix oil and flour together.
