Children get really excited about painting with water. This is ideal for those who are just beginning to learn how to form letters or need more practice tracing over them. If they are just starting out and/or need practice making large letters, it is best to do this outside. That way letters can be made large and the children have plenty of space to make large movements. Children can trace the letters written in chalk using paintbrushes dipped in water
