### Learning Opportunities

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## SPOOKY PHONICS

Turn it into a spooky Halloween game with spooky autumnal objects!

Talk about how the first sound you say in a word is the one that we are going to listen out for, and emphasise how to hear and say each on by saying it out loud and segmenting it from the rest of the word. "This is a dddd-og" so what's the first sound that it begins with? Each object your child picks up, encourage them to say its name and hear its first sound, before deciding which basket to place it in.
